

RESOLUTION NO. 20150121
A RESOLUTION OF THE
HAYS TRINITY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT
TO SUPPORT THE CYPRESS CREEK WATERSHED PROTECTION PLAN

WHEREAS, The Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District (“HTGCD”) has as its purpose the conservation, preservation and protection of the Trinity Aquifer in western Hays County; and

WHEREAS, The HTGCD Board members are elected officials with full authority to regulate the Trinity Aquifer including permitting of groundwater wells and governing all groundwater issues within the HTGCD boundary and in accordance with HTGCD Rules; and

WHEREAS, The HTGCD recognizes and supports the important role that stakeholder groups play in protecting the environment including the commitment of the CCWPP to safeguard the quality of both surface water and wastewater management. HTGCD does not endorse the creation of a special management area within its existing boundary; and


WHEREAS, The HTGCD Board supports and encourages the outreach and educational plans outlined in the CCWPP to aid the community in understanding local and regional water quality issues; and

WHEREAS, The HTGCD supports the Meadows Center’s proposal to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality specific to the protection of surface water quality and wastewater management within the Wimberley Valley.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by its Board of Directors that the Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District hereby recommends and approves:

- 1) Support of the Meadows Center’s proposal to the TCEQ specific to surface water quality and wastewater management within the Wimberley Valley.


