

RESOLUTION NO. 20111004
A RESOLUTION OF THE
HAYS TRINITY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT
TO CHANGE ELECTION DATES AND TERMS OF OFFICES.

WHEREAS, Hays County will no longer contract to conduct elections on the May Uniform Election Day in even numbered years because the state-wide election schedule for runoff elections was moved to May in even numbered years; and

WHEREAS, conducting elections requires the use of voting equipment and services of the Hays County; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 100, passed by the 82nd Legislature and effective September 1, 2011, amended Section 41.0052, Election Code, to allow a governing body of a political subdivision that holds its general election for officers on a date other than the November uniform election date to change the date on which it holds its general election for officers to the November uniform election date; and


WHEREAS, Section 41.0052, Election Code, requires a governing body changing an election date under that section to also adjust the terms of office to conform to the new election date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:


1. The election for Directors of the Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District will now be held on the November Uniform Election Date each year, beginning with the 2012 election.
2. That the term of office for Directors in Districts 1, 3 and 5 are extended to a term of May 2010 through November 2012.
3. That the term of office for Directors in Districts 2 and 4 are extended to a term of May 2011 through November 2013.
