**THE JOINT COORDINATING COMMITTEE OF GROUNDWATER
MANAGEMENT AREA 10**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REMOVAL OF THE
TERRITORY OF HAYS TRINITY GROUNDWATER
CONSERVATION DISTRICT FROM GROUNDWATER
MANAGEMENT AREA TEN**

WHEREAS, the Joint Coordinating Committee of Groundwater Management Area Ten (GMA 10) comprises delegates designated by the following Groundwater Conservation Districts (GCDs) located wholly or partially within GMA 10: Barton Springs/Edwards Aquifer Conservation District; Edwards Aquifer Authority; Guadalupe County GCD; Hays Trinity GCD; Kinney County GCD; Medina County GCD, Plum Creek CD; Trinity Glen Rose GCD, and Uvalde County GCD; and;

WHEREAS, Chapter 36.108 of the Texas Water Code, Joint Planning in Management Area), requires that the GCDs in GMA 10 perform joint planning necessary to consider and adopt Desired Future Conditions for all relevant aquifers in the GMA for a fifty-year planning period; and

WHEREAS, the GCC Board Presidents or their designated District Representatives of the GCDs in GMA 10 have met as a committee in various meetings and conducted joint planning in accordance with Chapter 36.108 of the Texas Water Code; and

WHEREAS, the territory of the Hays Trinity GCD that is located in GMA 10 is located at the northwestern margin of GMA 10 and is very small compared to other GMA 10 GCDs and accordingly the use of its groundwater resources is not likely to be effectively planned as part of GMA 10 ;

WHEREAS, most of the territory of Hays Trinity GCD is located in GMA 9, and all groundwater resources in Hays Trinity GCD, including those currently in GMA 10, are more likely to be effectively planned and managed as part of GMA 9; and

WHEREAS, the Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District (the District) desires to participate fully in the joint planning being conducted by GMA 9 for developing appropriate desired future conditions for the aquifers common to all GCDs in GMA 9, and has approved a resolution that requests GMA 10 to approve the transfer of that part of the District currently mapped as part of GMA 10 to GMA 9; and

WHEREAS, GMA 9 has expressed willingness to favorably consider adding the territory of the District currently in GMA 10 to its GMA; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Water Development Board requires that requests for transfers of land between adjacent GMAs be approved by resolution of both the GMA in which the territory is currently located and the GMA in which the territory would be located if approved by TWDB;;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Joint Planning Committee of GMA 10:

1. approves and accepts the removal of all of that part of the Hays Trinity GCD that is now in Groundwater Management Area 10;
2. endorses the inclusion of that same territory in the joint planning area of Groundwater Management Area 9; and
3. requests the Texas Water Development Board to approve that transfer as soon as feasible.
