ORDER DETERMINING THAT DROUGHT CONDITION TRIGGERS FOR THE JACOBS WELL GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT ZONE HAVE ENTERED THE VOLUNTARY CURTAILMENT STAGE

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District (HTGCD) reviewed, considered, and passed the entering of Voluntary curtailment for the Jacob's Well Groundwater Management Zone (JWGMZ); and

WHEREAS, the trigger conditions of Jacob's Well have moved into the Voluntary Curtailment drought condition of 11.14 cubic feet per second (11.14 cfs) for a 10-day running average; and

WHEREAS, District staff posted the Voluntary drought curtailment on the District website; and


WHEREAS, all active Non-Exempt Permit Holders will receive a drought stage notification on November 5, 2021 that HTGCD has now declared no mandatory drought curtailment with an effective date of November 5, 2021; and

WHEREAS, all Exempt and Non-Exempt well owners within the JWGMZ are encouraged by the Board to conserve groundwater;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF HAYS TRINITY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, HAYS COUNTY, TEXAS, THAT:

- 1) The Board recognizes and adopts the establishment of 0% curtailment conditions within the JWGMZ for all Non-Exempt Permit Holders; and
- 2) The Board requests that all users within the JWGMZ use caution and care with water use throughout the voluntary curtailment period; and
- 3) Voluntary curtailment conditions will stay in effect for the JWGMZ until further notice.
