**ORDER TO WAIVE CONSTRUCTION APPLICATION FEES on CERTAIN
DEDICATED MONITOR WELLS**

WHEREAS, the Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District (the District) has created in Rule the Jacobs Well Groundwater Management Zone (JWGMZ) for the study and management of the Jacobs Well Spring; and

WHEREAS, the District utilizes data from monitor wells in order to measure aquifer conditions in the JWGMZ with greater accuracy and precision; and

WHEREAS, the District makes critical and timely policy decisions based on aquifer condition data and science; and

WHEREAS, the Barton Springs/Edwards Aquifer Conservation District has agreed to construct at its own expense two dedicated monitor wells in the JWGMZ to gather aquifer data for scientific study and for the mutual benefit of both Districts; and

WHEREAS, the District has authorized the construction of these dedicated monitor wells in the JWGMZ; and

WHEREAS, Rule 3.1.1 requires the payment of a monetary fee for well construction applications; and

WHEREAS, the waiver of the District's fee is greatly outweighed by the well construction cost savings and scientific benefit to the District;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF HAYS TRINITY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, HAYS COUNTY, TEXAS, THAT:

- 1) The Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District shall waive the well construction fees for two dedicated monitor wells in the Jacobs Well Management Zone for the mutual enrichment of aquifer science in the Trinity Aquifer.
