Properly registered speakers must limit Public Comments to 5 minutes for all topics. All Public Comments will be made during the Public Comments section of the hearing. Any person participating in the hearing must be recognized and identified by the Presiding Officer each time they speak. The District will accept written comments on Item 1 through Wednesday, March 30, and on Item 2 through Tuesday, April 5, 2022. Written comments may be submitted by email to staff3@haysgroundwater.com or by mail to PO Box 1648, Dripping Springs, TX 78620. **Formal Contested Case Letters** on Item 2 shall be mailed to the PO Box above and will be accepted through April 5, 2022. A preliminary hearing following the public hearing shall take place in the event of a timely filed formal contested case letter.
