The Board of Directors reserve the right to take any and all appropriate actions regarding the redistricting of Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District political boundaries, including the acceptance of new boundaries for the Board of Directors' districts, modification of any boundaries, and/or tabling the pending proposals for later consideration and/or action. Oral comments may be presented at the Hearing and require submitting a Public Participation Form to the Board before the Hearing begins.
