ORDER RENEWING AND CORRECTING OPERATING PERMITS

ON THIS DAY CAME ON TO BE HEARD the above-styled and numbered matter.

1. On February 22, 2007, the Board of Directors (“Board”) of the Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District (“District”) approved issuance of original annual operating Permit No. 29 to Wimberley Water Supply Corporation (“Applicant”) for up to 695 acre-feet per year.

2. On September 17, 2009, the District approved Permit No. 82 to Applicant, a renewal of Permit No. 29.

3. On February 21, 2011, the Board approved Permit No. 169 to Applicant for up to 750 acre-feet per year for a term of three years, starting on March 1, 2011, and ending on February 28, 2014.

4. On July 30, 2013, the District approved renewal of Permit No. 169 to Applicant for a term of three years, starting on January 1, 2014, and ending on December 31, 2016.

5. On January 1, 2016, the General Manager approved renewal of Permit No. 169 to Applicant for an agreed upon, reduced amount of up to 645 acre-feet per year.

6. On January 1, 2019, the General Manager approved renewal of Permit No. 169 to Applicant for up to 645 acre-feet per year for a term of one year.

7. On January 1, 2020, the General Manager approved renewal of Permit No. 169 to Applicant for up to 645 acre-feet per year for a term of one year.

8. On January 1, 2022, the Board approved the renewal and disaggregation of Permit No. 169 for up to 430 acre-feet per year and issued Special Management Zone Permit No. 211 with an authorized withdrawal amount of up to 215 acre-feet per year.

9. On January 1, 2023, the General Manager approved renewal of Permit Nos. 169 and 211 to Applicant.

10. By its Permit Renewal Application for Permit Nos. 169 and 211, Applicant has requested that the District renew its permits for 750 acre-feet per year for a term of one year, based on the District's February 21, 2011, and July 30, 2013 approvals of Permit No. 169 to Applicant for 750 acre-feet per year.

11. District staff has reviewed this matter and recognizes that for the 2016 reissuance of its permit, Applicant voluntarily agreed not to exercise 105 acre-feet of its groundwater withdrawal rights but now desires to have the ability to exercise those rights in the area outside of the Jacobs Well Groundwater Management Zone.

12. The General Manager recommends that the Board reissue Permit No. 169 for 535 acre-feet per year and Permit No. 211 for 215 acre-feet per year.

13. The notice of meeting of the regular meeting of the Board on January 11, 2024, was duly and timely posted at the District and on the District's website.

14. Accordingly, the Board is of the opinion and finds that this Order should be GRANTED.


